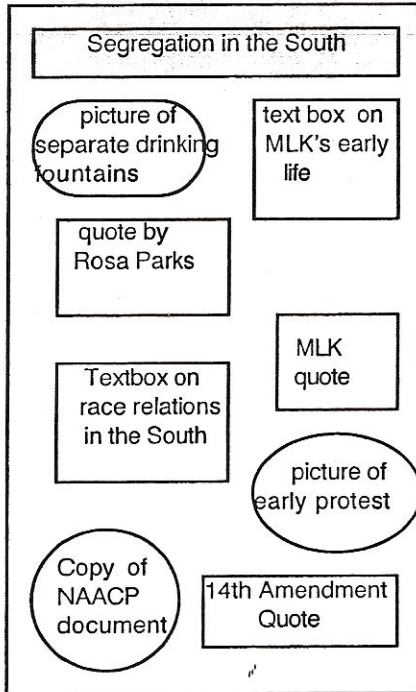

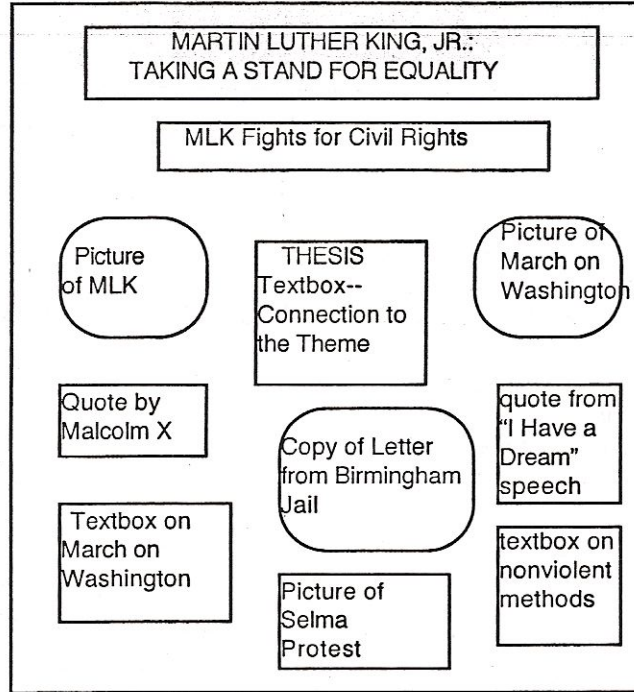
## D. Rough Draft of Exhibit:
