Committed as follows: ^{to-wit:} The said *John Doe, whose true name is unknown!*, *Richard Poe, whose true name is unknown!*, and *Jack Robinson, whose true name is unknown!* on the fifteenth day of June A. D. 1920, at the City of Duluth in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, with a premeditated design to effect the death of one Isaac W. White a human being, did, wrongfully, unlawfully, wilfully and feloniously kill the said Isaac W. White by then and there striking the said Isaac W. White with a paper which said killing of him, the said Isaac W. White by them, the said *John Doe, whose true name is unknown!*, *Richard Poe, whose true name is unknown!* and *Jack Robinson, whose true name is unknown!* was then and there without excuse, justification or authority of law.

Contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Minnesota.
